

iMobile: Setting Off-Duty Time

Providers who utilize their personal devices for accessing iMobile (a.k.a. BYOD) have the ability to set an off-duty timer to automatically log them out of iMobile (a.k.a. MH-CURE) at a designated time of their choosing. Having the Off-Duty feature enabled ensures that the user will receive no iMobile notifications after the designated time and until the next time they login.

Upon logging into iMobile, users are prompted to enable the Off-Duty Time feature. If they choose to turn it on, they will then be prompted to set the time they would like to go into Off-Duty mode.

Upon Initial Login

<p>BYOD users will be prompted at their initial login to enable the Off-Duty Time feature.</p> <p>Note: If the user does not wish to use this feature they may choose the option to disable it.</p>	<p>Toggle the switch to enable this feature and choose an appropriate time you wish to be logged out of MH-CURE.</p> <p>Note: This time must be at least 5 minutes from the current time.</p>	<p>Upon login your status time will reflect your designated logoff time on the MH-CURE dashboard as a confirmation.</p> <p>Note: You can set a custom message to display while logged in which can remain present after you have been logged out.</p>

Logout and Notifications

<p>Display when application is backgrounded</p>	<p>Display when app is active</p>	<p>Upon user's next login they will receive a reminder notification that they must login to begin receiving push notifications.</p>



Note

- Selecting the option **Disable this feature** ensures that the system will no longer prompt the user for their Off-Duty time when they log in.
- If a user wishes to by-pass the timer they can select **Done** at the top of the window. However, on their next login, they will be able to set an Off-Duty time.

If a user bypasses the Off Duty Time at login and then wishes to set it, they can access the Off-Duty screen by opening the iMobile **Dashboard** and selecting **More**. From there, select the **Off-Duty Time** option to set the timer.
